

**To those who suffered damages by the torrential rains on September of Year Heisei 27  
in the Kanto and Tohoku regions 平成 27 年 9 月関東・東北豪雨による被害を受けた皆様へ  
(Notice from Shimodate Tax office and Joso City 下館税務署・常総市からのお知らせ)**

We would like express our sincere sympathy to all citizens who have suffered damages caused by the disaster due to the torrential rains on September of Year Heisei 27 in the Kanto and Tohoku regions.

Those who have damages by this disaster may have a total or partial reduction of the income tax of the year Heisei 27, by applying “casualty loss deduction system” or “reduction or exemption for the public obligations act for the disaster victims”.

Therefore, we, Shimodate Tax office and Joso City, will hold a pre-filling consultation sessions targeting for those who were affected, as shown below.

**Consultation Sessions about Deduction of Losses resulted from Disaster, Accident, etc.**

Date: from Feb. 2 (Tue.) to Feb. 9 (Tue.), excluding Saturday and Sunday

Time: Open from 9:00 to 12:00 and from 13:00 to 16:00

Place: Building Annex-3 of Joso City Hall (in Mitsukaido office), and Meeting room in Ishige office

Those who intend to come the consultation meeting shall carry the below document with you.

- The documents necessary for the estimation of the damage amount.
  - ① A document that indicate the acquisition value and the date you have acquired the damaged assets. (Contract of the building construction, etc.)
  - ② If you have not the acquisition value, a document shows the construction area of the damaged assets. (Registration certificate, etc.)
  - ③ A document that shows demolition cost, removal cost or repairing cost of the damaged assets. (Invoice, receipt, etc.)
  - ④ A document that indicates the insurance reimbursement for the damaged assets (Insurance payment notice, etc.)
  - ⑤ If you have got received a certificate “Risai Shoumeisho”, submit the copy of it.
- The documents necessary for the “Kakutei Shinkoku”. (Annual Declaration of the Income for Taxation)  
Such as Gensen choushuhyou, Aoiro Shinkoku kessansho, Balance sheet, etc.
- ※ If you have a copy of the “Kakutei Shinkoku” of the previous year Heisei 26, please bring it together with the above documents
